WHO WE ARE

The Warren County Water and Sewer Department is a regional water supplier that builds and operates world-class treatment facilities providing safe and reliable drinking water to our customers. The County owns and operates two water treatment plants with a total rated capacity of 24 million gallons per day serving over 34,000 water customers. We maintain 750 miles of water mains, 1,500 main line valves, and 6,500 fire hydrants.

The department also operates five wastewater treatment plants serving over 25,000 sewer customers. We maintain over 340 miles of sanitary sewers and over 70 lift stations.

The department operates with a 50 million dollar budget that covers expenses and capital projects. Warren County Water and Sewer has its own finance division along with a customer service, geographic information system, backflow prevention division, engineering, and instrument and controls divisions.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE
