The Warren County Sheriff's Office is establishing an eligibility list for the open position of Corrections Officer. All eligible applicants must complete and submit an application, testing processes will be scheduled accordingly.

Why the Warren County Sheriff's Office?

- Extensive FTO program and corrections academy within first year of employment.
- •Approved VA training facility. Eligible veterans can receive on the job training reimbursements.
- Starting annual salary of \$42,328

What is the hiring process?

- 1. Submit your application, resumes are not accepted without completed applications.
- 2. If selected, you will be invited to attend a physical fitness* and written exam.
- 3. Oral interview
- 4. Truth Verification Process
- 5. Extensive background investigation
- 6. Physical/Drug Screen
- 7. Psychological exam

What are the requirements?*

- 1. You must be 18 years old or older.
- 2. Be a citizen of the United States.
- 3. You must possess or be able to acquire, and maintain a valid Ohio drivers license.
- 4. High school diploma or equivalent.
- 5. Must be of high moral character.
- 6. No tattoos which are visible while wearing a required uniform.
