

No-Mow Test Zone

The Park District is testing out no-mow zones in certain small areas of our parks where the turfgrass is not being used for athletics or other recreational uses. As a natural resource conservation agency, we are always looking for ways to reduce our environmental impact.

These zones will be mowed at least once yearly to control invasive woody vegetation. Our future plan is to enhance areas over time with native wildflowers as funding permits.

Benefits of No-Mow Zones

- Reduce mowing time, freeing up time for park maintenance staff to improve the parks.
- Reduce fuel usage and equipment maintenance costs.
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions from mowing equipment.
- Provide habitat for desirable birds and pollinators, while deterring undesirable wildlife like geese.
